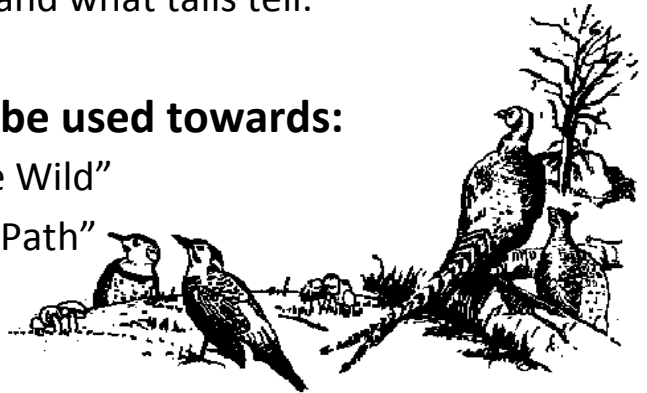
Tigers: “Backyard Jungle”, “Tigers in the Wild”
